

Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the first week of October!

Has anyone purchased any mums or pumpkins yet? Before you know it, we will be finished decorating for the Fall and preparing our Thanksgiving menus.

The Fall Scholastic Book Fair is here! Every classroom teacher has signed up for a specific time to bring their students to the book fair during the school day. We also have planned a Family Night this Wednesday from 6 - 8 pm in case you would like to visit as a family. Please check out the PTA News section below for more details and information about this event.

This is a friendly reminder to please be sure to send your child in to school in the appropriate weather attire. We have moved our Lost & Found to a nook outside of our cafeteria. Therefore, if you believe your child has already misplaced a sweater, sweatshirt, or jacket, please have them inform their teacher and the teacher will send them to the Lost & Found.

Do you know our three main Caln expectations? RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, and SAFETY. Students are expected to practice our expectations everywhere they go.

Everyone at Caln has been informed about our expectations. We will continue to hold our expectations to a high regard in and around our Caln community. It is also imperative that our parents hold their children accountable too. We must work together to ensure that all students are learning in a safe environment and that if your child does not follow these correct actions and behaviors then consequences will follow. Please keep in mind that our next Have A Hoot day is quickly approaching.

A few important reminders are listed below, beginning with any new information.

- Our school nurse, Mrs. Caren Diamond, is here to help students during the school day when students need her care from scrapes, bumps, allergies, and illnesses during school time. Please be sure to monitor your child's safety and care at home. If needed, there are several Urgent Care Centers in and around our community during home time and on the weekends. I have included a few helpful resources below.
- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered tardy after 9:30 AM - attendance is being closely monitored.
- School instructional times are 9:15 am 3:45 pm.
- Main Office Hours: The main office hours are 8:00 am -4:30 pm.

Early Dismissal: A note/email should be sent in the morning to <u>CNAttendance@casdschools.org</u>. The note for early dismissals should contain:
 Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.
 All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.
 The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).

- **Refillable water bottles**: Caln has transitioned to bottle filling stations. Students should bring a refillable water bottle to school.
- Transportation: Students assigned to a bus must get on/off the assigned bus stop. Please be at the bus stop to receive students at the assigned times. We appreciate your cooperation.
- Parent-Pick-Up Notes & Reminder: Thank you for having patience with us as we work to make our afternoon dismissal more efficient. If your child needs to be picked up for an early dismissal or rides a school bus, please help us with this by sending a parent pick-up note into school with your child(ren) or email cnattendance@casdschools.org. If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS): We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: RESPECT,
 RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY. I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.


